2010 Mocine S'Indora

A pure expression of the little-used Foglia Tonda grape variety, the 2010 S'Indora delivers a dark, rich consistency and pungent aromas of wild berry, green peppercorn, rosemary sprig and exotic spice. The wine reveals a great sense of inner richness and darkness with a masculine, brooding personality. Tight tannins and some sour fruit aromas appear on the close. There is a rustic or raw quality to the wine that suits it very nicely. The results are charming and unpredictable. This wine should be consumed within the next five years.

2013 Mocine Mocine

The 2013 Mocine (an IGT Toscana wine) is a blend of Sangiovese, Colorino, Foglia Tonda and Barsaglina. This motley collection of native Tuscan grapes creates a beautifully intense bouquet with round tones of dark cherry, spice, chocolate and moist chewing tobacco. There's a plump, almost sweet quality to the fruit that gives the wine a succulent style. This wine is made with organically-farmed grapes.
